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What is ISP Prep?

ISP Prep is a new initiative that will increase student access and exposure to industry through virtual WBL with industry professionals, preparing them for internships, apprenticeships, and workplace challenges.

Over a period of four weeks, over 500 students in 8 different professional tracks (Automotive and Transportation, Construction, Finance, Healthcare, Culinary, Hospitality, Media & Design, and IT) will attend 20 hours of workshops and webinars run by industry leaders which will increase their understanding of the post-high school working world. Industry leaders will discuss a range of topics from how they became involved in their work, to general professional skills).

All activities will be interactive, encouraging communication, collaboration, and group work.

What's the timing?

ISP Prep sessions launch Monday, 1/24.


ISP Prep sessions conclude Friday, 2/18.

Your session will run 1 – 2 hours, and the date and time of your session is based entirely on your availability.

Who is involved in ISP Prep?

There are a few groups of individuals involved in ISP Prep:

- Students: High School sophomores and juniors on one of 8 CTE tracks
- Program Coordinators: Our staff of program coordinators help to set up workshops and presentations, and are here to answer questions from both you and students
- Industry Professionals: People like you!



Where does ISP Prep happen?

ISP Prep is entirely virtual. Your session will either be pre-recorded or will be occur over Zoom.

What's the time commitment?

Each workshop requires 1-2 hours of your time. Prior to the workshop, you'll need to participate in one or two planning sessions to ensure all runs smoothly. We'll supply you with materials (templates, samples) to assist with overall preparation.

What am I responsible for?

First, you'll answer some questions that we send to you. Your answers create the base for your presentation.

Next, we'll create a presentation template from your answers. Prior to your presentation, you'll want to review and if you like, practice.

The day of the presentation, you'll be responsible for delivering a 1 – 2 hour presentation.
